#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

a Quality matt acrylic paint for walls and ceilings with a low odour, with excellent coverage for interior and exterior use.

#### **INTENDED USES:**

- 1. Final coat for walls & ceilings.
- 2. Correctly prepared unglazed brick and cement plaster free of hairline cracks.
- 3. Sound previously painted surfaces walls and ceilings.
- 4. Correctly prepared gypsum plaster and fibre cement boards.

#### **FEATURES:**

1. Water-based Easy to clean painter tools, low odour and quick drying.

Low splatter Easy mess-free application.

Smooth matt finish Excellent coverage and hiding properties.

4. Good washability Resists formation of shiny patches when cleaning.5. Good adhesion Can be applied to previously coated, sound surfaces.

7. Low VOC, reduces the odour associated with painting indoors.

STORAGE: PACKAGING:

Keep containers properly sealed.

5Lt, 10Lt, 20Lt

Store away from direct heat, sun and severe cold in a place with adequate ventilation.

### **APPLICATION DETAILS:**

Mixing: Stir well before use with a flat paddle to an even consistency. Stir occasionally during

use.

Method: Roller (long high loading pile) brush or airless spray.

Thinning: Not recommended.

Cleaning: Remove as much of the product as possible from the application equipment before

cleaning with water.

Application Conditions: <u>Surface Temperature</u> <u>Ambient Temperature</u> <u>Relative Humidity</u>

or 3°C above dew point, if possible away from direct sunlight

Note: higher temperatures will accelerate the drying times (approximately halved for every 10°C increase) whilst lower temperatures will retard the drying times

(approximately doubled for every 10°C decrease).

Requirements: 2 coats minimum.

#### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

Surfaces must be sound, clean and dry (moisture content below 15%) before painting. Newly applied plaster need to be left for 21 to 28 days or 1 week for every 5mm thickness of plaster. Undesirable weather conditions e.g. cold or wet weather conditions will results in extended curing period.

Plaster sand to comply with SABS 1090 requirements. Plaster mix must have a minimum thickness of 10mm, free from soft and friable material and comply with SABS 0164-1 for strength (MPA).

1. New work:

1. 1 Exterior cement plaster Apply directly or as final coat prime with one coat Prominent Damp

Cure or Prominent Select Plaster Primer.

1. 2 Interior cement plaster Apply directly or as final coat prime with one coat Prominent Select

Plaster Primer or Prominent Wall Primer.

1. 3 Gypsum plaster/board Prime with one coat Prominent Select Plaster Primer.

1. 4 Fibre cement Prime with one coat Prominent Damp Cure or Prominent Select

Plaster Primer.

2. Redecorating:

It is advisable to test the compatibility of coatings when redecorating is involved, i.e. paint a small section and then check the adhesion after 48 hours by applying a strip of masking tape and attempting to rip the paint off.

2.1 Gloss Paint or Eggshell Enamel Sand to a matt finish, clean with PROMINENT GP Cleaner diluted

1:10 with water and an abrasive pad, rinse and allow to dry before

applying one coat Prominent Select Universal Undercoat.

### SURFACE PREPARATION

2.2 Sheen Emulsion paint Sand to a matt finish, clean with PROMINENT GP Cleaner diluted

1:10 with water and an abrasive pad, rinse and allow to dry before

applying one coat Prominent Select Universal Undercoat.

2.3 Powdery and chalky surfaces High-pressure water jet cleaning on exterior surface or fo

High-pressure water jet cleaning on exterior surface or for interior surfaces clean with PROMINENT GP Cleaner diluted 1:10 with water and an abrasive pad, rinse with water and allow to dry then apply one coat Prominent Damp Cure, Prominent Surface

Restorer or Prominent Select Plaster Primer.

Strip down and treat as new work.

### **LIMITATIONS:**

1. Cannot be applied in cold and moist conditions.

- 2. Cannot be applied as an intermediate coating.
- 3. Cannot be applied on a rough surface like Trowel-on or scratch plaster.
- 4. Product cannot accommodate excessive movement, i.e. Hairline cracking or application onto flexible coatings like textured coats and waterproofing systems can lead to mud cracking.
- 5. Cannot be applied over poor quality undercoats or directly onto gypsum plaster.
- 6. Cannot be used for bridging hairline cracks.
- 7. Spot touching up over large areas will be noticeable.
- 8. Life expectancy only relevant when used as a final coat.
- 9. To ensure a consistent colour appearance, ensure that batch numbers on all the containers are the same. Where the batch numbers differ, intermix before use.

#### **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:**

1. Keep out of reach of children.

2.4 Poor condition surfaces

- 2. Ensure to maintain good ventilation during application and drying process.
- 3. Wear a suitable dust mask if sanding.
- 4. In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water or a recognised skin cleaner. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes rinse immediately with running water and seek medical advice.
- 5. If product is ingested drink plenty of water. Do not induce vomiting at any time. Seek medical advice.
- 6. Do not smoke while painting.

- 8. To avoid any risk of spillage, always transport in a secure upright position.
- 9. If the surface to be painted is asbestos then the preparation, cleaning and/or removal of broken asbestos sheeting needs to be done in compliance to the Asbestos Regulations, 2001 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1993.
